Learning Outcomes

Participants will demonstrate

- Knowledge and application of relevant legislation, policies and procedures in the context undertaking child protection assessments.
- Knowledge and application of the Principles and Disciplines of Signs of Safety Child Protection Framework when working with children and families and Sector Staff.
- Knowledge and application of indicators, context, dynamics of child abuse (emotional (including domestic violence; physical abuse, neglect and sexual abuse).
- Knowledge and application of child development, trauma and impact of abuse when undertaking child protection assessment.
- Develop self-care strategies when working in the Department.
