- Closed Group. Maximum of 10 participants.
- Monthly clinical supervision for 6 – 8 months. You will be sent times and dates for all sessions after registering and being accepted for the first session on 24 January 2019.
- Quarterly training morning and supervision afternoon sessions.
- Facilitated by Clinical Psychologist at Learning & Development.
- Co-ordination and Co-facilitation by Senior Practice Development Officer, Learning and Development.
